The Storm Chronicles are an adult album alternative and progressive rock music project. The duo was established on the vision of David Burr, who founded and developed the project as the primary vehicle for delivering his music/lyrics. Burr selected the songs for the debut album from the substantial backlog of material and demos he had developed over the course of almost 20 years. After recruiting vocalist Jody Dietz in 2011, the duo spent the next two years recording the album. The end result was *Looking Backward*, released in September 2013. The music and lyrics were composed by Burr, with additional writing contributions by Dietz. The album was produced, recorded and mixed by Burr.
